WHO IT'S FOR

Senior teams — executive committees, EGM/GM leadership groups, and the L&D or transformation leaders who commission for them. Groups of 8–20. No technical background assumed; seniority is.

FORMAT

2 consecutive days, in your building, on your tools and your material. Pre-work is one 30-minute survey of the workflows that eat your team's week. Facilitated by practitioners who build production AI systems, not presenters.

WHAT PEOPLE LEAVE WITH

- ♦ A calibrated sense of what these systems do well, badly, and confidently wrong
- ♦ 2 of their own workflows redesigned and tested in the room
- ♦ A verification habit proportionate to real stakes
- ♦ A shared team vocabulary for delegation and escalation

Knowing what these systems *actually are*.

09:00

The honest state of play

What frontier models can do this quarter — demonstrated live on your industry's work, not slideware. Where the capability curve is, and where it is heading on the only timescale that matters to your planning cycle.

Leaves you with: a current, vendor-free capability map.

10:30

Calibration — trust, distrust, and the expensive middle

Hands-on. Where models excel, where they degrade, and where they fail confidently. You build your own error model by catching real failures in real outputs, live.

Leaves you with: a personal read on when to trust an output — and when to check.

13:00

Your workflows, decomposed

The core skill: carving a real piece of your knowledge work into machine-shaped and human-shaped pieces. Each participant works their own live task from the pre-work survey.

Leaves you with: 1 of your own workflows redesigned, run, and reviewed.

15:30

Reading the vendor

Model cards, evaluations, benchmark claims and demo theatre. How to ask the 3 questions that collapse a weak pitch, and how to recognise a strong one.

Leaves you with: a procurement-grade sniff test you can run in any meeting.

From personal skill to *team practice*.

09:00

Specification — briefing the machine like a senior hire

Context, constraints, format, what good looks like. The discipline is delegation, not prompting — and it is why good managers get fluent fastest.

Leaves you with: a specification pattern that transfers to every tool you use.

10:30

Verification regimes and escalation

Designing the checking that matches the stakes: what gets read line-by-line, what gets sampled, what needs a second human. Includes the escalation conversation — what goes up, and what you decide.

Leaves you with: a verification regime for your team's 3 highest-stakes outputs.

13:00

The second workflow — harder, together

Pairs redesign a shared, messier workflow end to end: split, specify, run, verify, and decide what happens to the time freed. The afternoon where it becomes a team capability.

Leaves you with: a 2nd redesigned workflow, and the method to keep going.

15:30

The 30 / 60 / 90

Each participant commits to specifics: which workflow next, what protected practice time, what the team stops doing. Written down, dated, and reviewed with your sponsor.

Leaves you with: a dated plan your sponsor has seen.
